#### 6/ League Registration 2013/14

As agreed at the AGM the League Registration will cost £10 for all ages except Under 10/12's who will pay £5 registration fee. Registration will only be accepted via the BC Website utilizing the Club Registration Tool (The Waldron's WMCCL will be set up on the BC site)
