ADDRESS

Stoneleigh NAEC, Stoneleigh Park, Stoneleigh, Kenilworth CV8 2LZ. Note that this postcode actually takes you to the centre of this vast 160-acre venue, but once through the security gates please follow our event signage and marshals who will corral you to your destination.

CAR PARKING

There is plenty of parking space for all competitors, but please still ensure you park sensibly. As with many of our league races the financial viability of hosting an event can only be guaranteed on the back of the monies collected for car parking – our car park charge will be £3 per vehicle.

Please ensure you follow the signs when you enter the venue beyond the security gates and follow the arrows on the graphic at the rear of this document this is to ensure that a) you don't get lost and b) that you are funnelled towards our marshals who will be on hand to take your car parking fee. PLEASE MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO COME WITH THE RIGHT CHANGE.

Please respect the venue and refrain from cleaning mud from your bike and person on the car park area, there is plenty of other grassed areas for a 'de-mudding' session if necessary

SIGN ON

Is located near the entrance to the car park – look out for the large RLSCC gazebo

CHANGING ROOMS

There are no showers or changing facilities available on site.

START

There are two different starts, one for the younger age categories and the other for youth and above categories – please familiarise yourself where these are in plenty of time for gridding. Access to the gridding area for the younger racers will be down past the team gazebo area. Access to the start for the older age categories will be past the sign on/toilets and down the road. The start for older age categories is a dedicated start and so allows for gridding in plenty of time whilst other races are being concluded on the course.

FINISH

For all races, the finish is adjacent to the open grass section of the course just down the slight hill from the car park and team gazebo area – the course will have crossing points to and from this, so please respect the marshal's decision in moving across the course. First three in any race required for interviews over the PA – be careful not to walk back over the timing chip line.

DOUBLE PITS

We have double pits and bike stands will be provided for unassisted riders – please use these sensibly and try not to hog the space way in advance of your race. The Stoneleigh NAEC venue is not a public space and so there should be nobody wandering around not involved in the event, but that doesn't preclude folks from taking care of the security of their own bikes and equipment.

PODIUM PRESENTATIONS

Presentations for all under 12s will take place at the finish/PA Area immediately after the under 12 races. RLSCC have a variety of special prizes for the u12s podium stars which have been donated by the 'Tour of Britain' to the club as a thankyou for our marshalling the Burton Dassett KOM at this year's race; so, what better way to reward our young CX stars of the future by dishing them out as prizes!!

An additional special mention needs to be made to the very kind people at Bike Box (www.bikeboxhirewarwickshire.co.uk) and The Giant Store Leamington Spa who have both also been very kind to donate towards the prize hoard for Sunday's race.

There will be a catering van on site located near the sign on gazebo serving hot drinks and snacks

DOGS

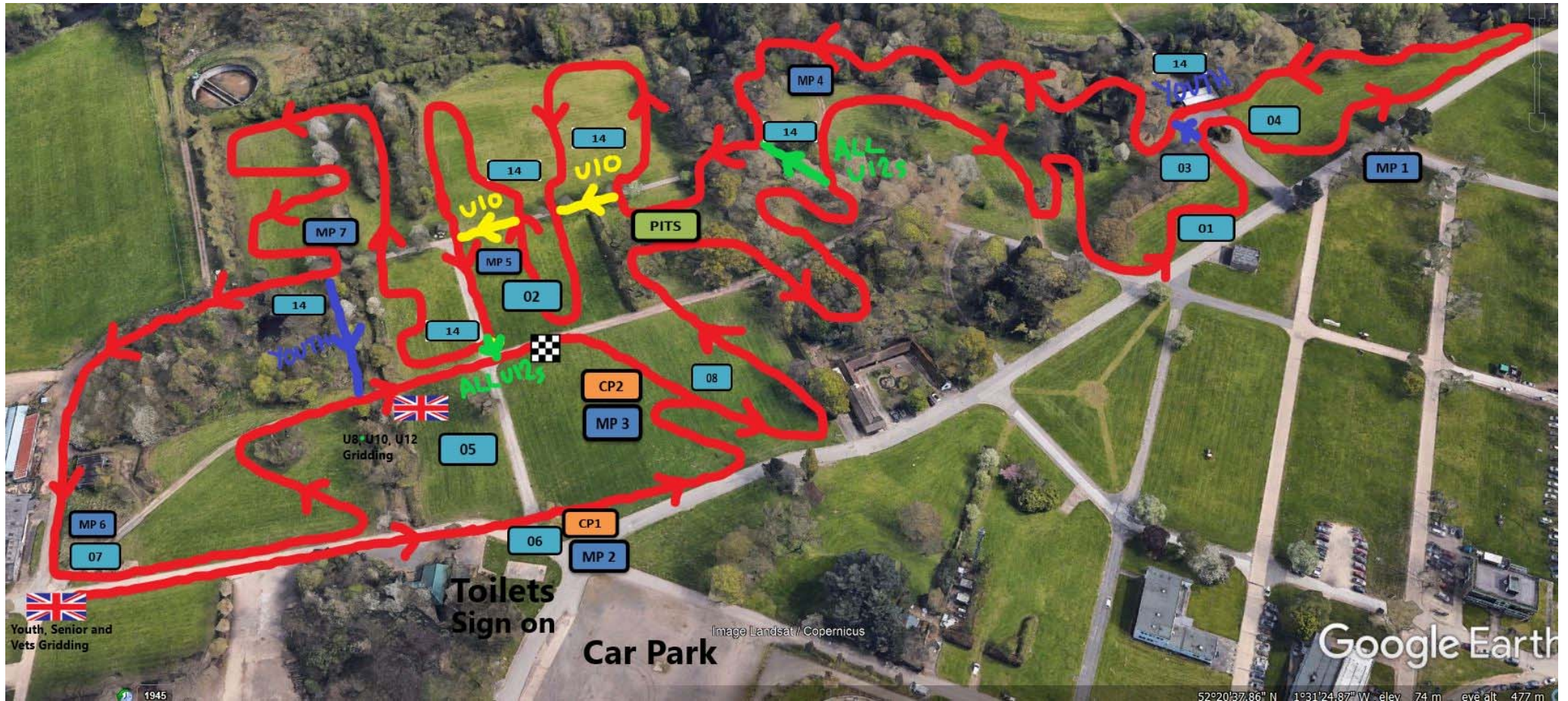
Please clean up after your dog and keep dogs on leads at all times.
