3/ Treasurer Report

Current balance stands at £10701 as of today's date less £150 [REDACTED] less £64 (BC Payment)
We have paid £8088 in levies to BC this season
£660 was paid out to cover Inter Areas entry fees and gesture towards travelling costs
Waldrons £2000 sponsorship is still due for this season
Income from Timing levy during season has been £12564 with £9900 paid out

4/ Secretary Report

Adrian Witt has promised the Waldron's sponsorship money will be forthcoming this season

5/ Review of Season

All events have been well received with excellent attendance. In total we have had 4156 rides av 378 competitors per event. With the consistent programme we have maintained numbers throughout the league series with limited impact where dates have clashed with National Trophy events. DMe raised the issue of inconsistent prizes between events and the challenge of physically paying out winnings. This is an area that all agreed we need to look at for next season to find a better way of managing prizes. Areas for future discussion include:

- Take a levy from each rider and centralize prize funds
- Pay winnings at the end of the season
- Prizes based on league positions vs event placings?
- Investigate electronic payment via BACS/bank transfer

DAG suggested a questionnaire could be issued to all registered riders to try and gauge what riders want to see next year. A draft to be circulated with a view to sending via BC newsletter to all WMCCL registered riders.

A question was raised re the low Junior numbers and what could be done to improve this?

6/ League Registration

This will be turned off in June and an email sent out to all this years registered riders inviting them to re register for 2014 season

7/ Race Day Timetable

This was discussed and it was agreed it works well and we should stick with it for next season
