



West Midlands Cyclo Cross League Round 8

The West Midlands Cyclocross League Round 8 at Baggeridge Country Park, 19th November 2017 is being hosted by Wolverhampton Wheelers and we are looking forward to welcoming you to the race.

Location:

Baggeridge Country Park. DY3 4HB

Main Entrance to the venue is via the A463 – Wodehouse Lane/Gospel End Lane, Gospel End, Sedgley

Please be aware that, the entrance to the park is a narrow road with passing places at regular intervals down to the carpark.

Car Parking:

Please be aware that parking could well be an issue depending on numbers attending and would request that people be sparing with how they park and be very patient with other park users.

Please be aware there is an **ALL DAY PARKING CHARGE OF £2.80p**. There will be parking wardens checking throughout the day, it's at your risk if you choose not pay !!

All car parks will be open including the over flow on the grass just after cattle grid on the left. Unfortunately we do not have exclusive use of the park so the general public will still have access to the park so again could I ask you to be patient.



Course:

We have tried to vary the course from the one set up by Halesowen to give some variation, however it uses most of the same paths and grass but in a different way and due to the rain we have had, it is likely to be muddy. The start is now next to the tented area and the pits on the first field. We have negotiated path closures coming onto the area being used for the course, we will do our best to police these areas so still please be aware of the general public wondering onto the course.



The exact route of the U8/10/12 course will be determined during the course set up as we will try to make more of it rideable rather than running through mud (although some running may be required!)

Sign On

Sign on and timing chips will be in the paddock area which can be accessed from the tented village area or the car park. Sign on will be open from about 9:00. Please give priority to the races that are taking place first however if you are signing on a child and yourself then we will do our best to accommodate you. We have negotiated path closures coming onto the area being used for the course, we will do our best to police these areas so still please be aware of the general public wondering onto the course.

Café and Facilities

The Country Park café will be stocked with bacon sandwiches, coffee, tea and cakes so please pay them a visit. The toilets are in the main block on the lower car park. Please endeavour to try and not take too much mud into either of these areas.

Spectator Area and Access

The tent area is the spectator area, please try and arrange your Gazebos/Tents so everyone can access the area and still be able to see the racing. Access should be possible to the amphitheatre via the normal paths and gap in the hedge but please use the crossing points which will be marshalled.

Access to the pits should be via the path from the car park and the start should be from the spectator area/car park.

The park is a public place and there will be members of the public that don't know anything about cycling so please be polite and courteous should they be in the way.
