

Practice sessions

There will be 2 practice sessions during the day and a course closed/open flag will be shown at the start finish.

Riders who have already raced should not ride the course in subsequent practice sessions and in earlier sessions riders racing later in the day should defer and give priority to riders in those categories about to race.

Are at rear of the brick building please take particular care to leave this area clean and tidy.
