## 2. Previous Minutes

## 3. Chairman's report

### 3.1. Prize presentation

- Venue was good but JP reports that no bookings are being taken beyond September 2023 & venues over 200pp are difficult to find. GRP keen to aim for >200pp attendance.
- Bringing the event forward to before the road racing season opens would help avoiding clashes.
- Evening event was discussed but not a huge clamour for it.
- Venue cost £2,410 and around £1,000 raised in ticket sales
- **Action HJ: Create a dropbox link to adult photos in link to promote the AGM**
- **Action – All: In case of queries advise that DM has all unclaimed trophies and medals.**

## 4. Treasurer's report

- 4.1. Islabike money £492 coming in for One-Bike trophies.
- 4.2. No income since last meeting expenditure on:
  - League medals,
  - One Bike Trophies,
  - AGM room hire,
  - Prize fund,
  - Storage.
- 4.3. Auditor has 5 weeks to review the accounts before the AGM.

## 5. AGM 28<sup>th</sup> May

- 5.1. GS has been dealing with the AGM.
- 5.2. Venue is booked 1pm – 5pm
- 5.3. Agreed AGM start at 2pm
  - Election of committee members & officials

- Need new Secretary – net needs to be cast a little wider.
- PV is prepared to stand as Treasurer.
- GRP a couple more potential members of the committee
- Need for diversity of thought e.g. clash with youth national series was not considered.'
- MD – queried a proposal to take the league out of the championships.
  - ME supportive of this in principle.
  - HJ explained that was BC preference from National Commissaire in lead up to the 2022 event.
  - GRP explained a need to discuss with Phil Metcalfe as WW have agreed a date based on the current situation.
- JP raised the issue of prize money v entry fees.
  - GRP complex issue. SCC were able to put money into the league bursary last season as profit was good.
  - GS – current system does not seem to have put off riders.
  - MD - need to be careful whether this would put off commercially minded organisers.
  - ME – would it encourage more people to come from out of region.
  - MD - ranking points is an issue with smaller field sizes.
  - JP – what are other leagues doing regarding prizes?
    - ME - Eastern, Central and NW give prizes on the day.
    - Leicestershire league – no car parking charge & every event has to pay a certain % into the league (similar to our levy).
  - HJ/GRP/GS - Current system rewards league members to greater depth than on-the-day prizes.
  - GRP big problem is the big hole in Jnr/u23 riders.

- GRP - Stratford looking at Ullenhall and Purity Brewery – don't own the land and referred to the landowner (farmer).

- Lakeside looking to put the car parking up to £5 per vehicle which may affect viability on top of £2 per rider levy to the venue. Should the league subsidise the parking in light of this.
- Not heard from Gator events on running an event but understand they are still keen to use Chillington Hall

#### 7.2. MD – Rider HQ feedback from last season?

- GRP favourably impressed but only drawback is publishing in two places.
  - Some organisers struggled with linking BC to the RiderHQ
  - Setting up each event by the league is difficult in terms of bank accounting
- MD – each week was still quite a lot of work., Too many opportunities for mistakes to be made. MD would like to get back to them with feedback on events.
- Going back to BC the system would be a step backwards
- GRP – would like to continue with RiderHQ but hold an organiser meeting to discuss and develop a better template with RiderHQ. Event will still need to be set up on the BC system.
- **Action – GRP/MD: GRP to arrange meeting with Ned (RiderHQ) to discuss improvements to the league.**
- **Action – GRP: Event organiser meeting to be arranged soon after the AGM.**

#### 7.3. GRP – Selling of kit?

- Good feedback received from those who received the zip-off tights.
  - Should the league consider selling tights or maybe war-up tops commercially to riders?
- Action – GRP: To put a proposal

#### 7.4. MD – League 2 year agreement with D3 Racetec coming up for renewal.

- **Action – MD: GRP requested MD put a proposal together.**
