Shrewsbury Sports Village, Sundorne Road, Shrewsbury, SY1 4RQ.

The Shrewsbury Sports Village is on the eastern side of Shrewsbury and is easily accessible from the North and South via the A49 and from the Midlands via the M6 and M54. Gates open at 8.00am.

Car Parking from 8.00am until 6.00pm
Overflow Parking 8.00am until 5.00pm

Competitor Parking is at Shrewsbury Sports Village - **HEIGHT RESTRICTION 2 METRES**

Overflow parking and over height parking is at the Severn Fields Health Village 8.00am until 5pm which is 100 metres past the Sports Village entrance and is closer to sign on than the Sports Village car park.



Please be aware that height restriction barriers are in place at the entrance and exit of Shrewsbury Sports Village. If the barriers are closed, please use the call button to Sports Village reception or use the overflow car park.

Please park responsibly and with respect to other competitors and other Sports activity.

Teams and Clubs can have 1 x EZ-Up each adjacent to the Finish Line – please see marshal before erecting.

Overnight parking of Campers is allowed in the Sports Village Car Park but the site will be closed at 6pm each night and will not reopen until 8.00am.

Please park Campers where directed. Please note height restriction barriers and call to reception for access to the site.

Sign On, Number and Timing Transponder Collection

Is located adjacent to our brand new Club Hub at the cycle track finish line which is located at the western end of the Sports Village below the Bowls Centre and Tennis Courts.

Season long numbers and timing transponders will be allocated to registered riders to be kept for the season.

Non-League riders are required to return numbers and transponders after their race.

Please ensure your allocated timing transponder is the same number as your race number.

Changing Rooms

Changing rooms and showers are in the main Sports Village building and are free to use.

Normal rules apply, no bikes, no muddy shoes and leave the changing rooms as you would like to find them.

Any issues with clogged drains, missing loo rolls etc, please report to the Sports Village staff as soon as possible. We'd like to come back.

Start and Start Loop

Is 100m below the finish line on the opposite side of the track. The course will run anti clockwise after the start loop. Access start loop from tennis court gate or finish line gate and around the outside of the cycle track which avoids excess crossing of the race route.



Finish

For all races the finish is adjacent to the sign on area.

Please exit the Cycle Circuit at the small gate at the top of the Cycle Circuit through the Tennis Courts. Do not double back over the finish line.

First three in any race will be required for podium presentation of medals for all under 12s and photo opportunity for other categories.

Double Pits

Are in the middle of the course next to “the green triangle” “Telly Tubby Land” and below the competition football pitch and at the end of a League pitch.

Please no riding or bike washing in the pits or riding bikes on any marked football pitches as the use of this grass area is highly political. There will be a pit marshal but for security, only rider helpers are allowed in the pits and as it is a public area, please only leave unattended bikes in the pits for the minimum amount of time.

The course direction means if you dismount on the left your helper will have to cross the pit lane riding line to give service, please ensure you have explained what is required to do this safely.

Prize Money

There is no on the day prize fund, but an amount will be paid to the West Midlands Cyclo Cross League towards an overall season fund. Details on the WMCCCL website.

Podium Presentation

Medal presentations for all under 12 races will take place at the PA area immediately after the under 12 races. All other races for a photo opportunity as soon as possible after each race finish.

Catering

The Shrewsbury Sports Village has its own Costa Coffee Café and a Deli Café for food during the day.

Water and Squash will be available all day at the Cycle Hub. There will also be boiling water available.



There is no outside catering as our regular Coffee Van is at Ludlow Food Festival.

Toilets

Are available in the Shrewsbury Sports Village. Please leave the toilets at our Club Hub for officials and volunteers to help them serve you better.

Dogs

Please clean up after your dog and always keep dogs on leads.
